On **Rosh Hashanah morning**, services will begin at 10:15am. Parents and Religious School aged children in 2nd Grade and above should all come to the Sanctuary TOGETHER. This will allow our families an opportunity to experience our main worship service in the Sanctuary together. After the initial segment of the service, an announcement will be made from the bimah, for children in 2nd - 6th grade to participate in an age-appropriate High Holy Day Experience. The children will have an interactive program for one hour, and then will return to the main service, allowing our youth the opportunity to rejoin their families in the Sanctuary to hear the Shofar and for the concluding prayers.

On **Yom Kippur**, we will come together as families again at 10:15am in the Sanctuary to begin our worship services. All children in Grades 2-6 will leave after the introductory prayers, however the students won't return to the Sanctuary, but rather have an opportunity to worship together in our age-appropriate worship experience.
